This is a temporary role, focused in the first instance, on the development of programmes and classes funded by TNLCF. There will be reviews of programme delivery at 3 and 6 months.

- The main purpose of this post is to develop new programmes, funded through our grant from TNLCF to support vulnerable people to start exercising and socialising again.
- To work with social prescribers and other local partner organisations to identify participants, recruit them to the programmes.
- To develop the marketing of Yorkshire Yoga and of these new programmes through social media and other means to reach as wide an audience as possible.
- To support the CEO in the running of the centre.
